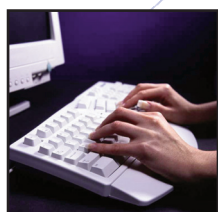

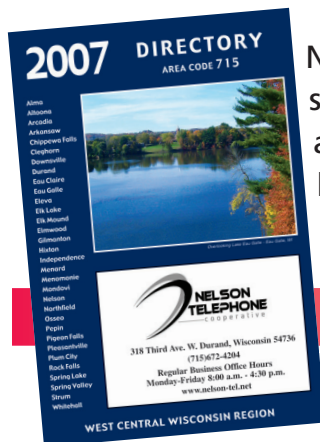

I would like to take this opportunity to thank you, the owners and customers of Nelson Telephone Cooperative, for your patronage and continued support this past year. All of us connected with Nelson Telephone Cooperative can look back at 2006 with a sense of pride in our accomplishments, remembering that they are the result of a close and effective partnership between our Members, the Board of Directors, Management and Staff.

We experienced a remarkable year of profits due in part to the liquidation and dissolution of the Rural Telephone Bank and the sale of our Midwest Wireless stock. As a member of our cooperative you share in this success.

During 2007 we will continue with our plan to move our cooperative forward and also continue with our Cooperative Improvement Plans that have been approved by the Rural Utilities Service. We will install approximately 40 miles of new buried fiber and copper cables which will be used to extend our enhanced broadband services. Our construction plans also include the installation of electronic equipment cabinets to which the new cables will be connected.

Our digital video plans are moving forward. We have a firm commitment to receive video signal from our neighboring telephone cooperative. These digital signals will then be sent to our subscribers over our fiber cable and electronic equipment. We hope to be able to offer a video package to our rural subscribers by this summer.

2006 was an active year and a productive year. We see 2007 as a year of further change in our industry and we are a cooperative that will continue to meet the many new challenges that we are faced with. My pledge to you is that the employees, management and board of directors at Nelson Telephone Cooperative will continue to work to provide you with the reliable, reasonably priced service that you deserve as member of the cooperative.

New National 811 "Call Before You Dig"

Number and Web Site to Launch May 1, 2007



One easy phone call to 811 gets the approximate location of underground utility lines marked for free. 811 is the new FCC-designated national N-11 number that quickly and easily begins the process of getting underground

lines marked as the first step in any digging project. The new 811 number eliminates the confusion of multiple "Call Before You Dig" numbers because it's easy to use and remember, and is the same in every state.

Much like the current "Call Before You Dig" services, calls will continue to be routed to the respective One Call Centers who will then notify the affected utilities, who will then mark underground lines for free.

Why 811? Knowing where your lines are buried before each digging project helps protect you from injury, expense and penalties. The depths of utility lines vary and multiple lines may exist in the same area. Damages to these lines can disrupt service to an entire neighborhood, harm diggers and cost diggers fine and repair costs.

Know what's below. Always call before you dig. Smart digging means calling 811 before each job because marked lines show diggers the approximate location of underground lines and help prevent undesired consequences. Now, with 811, there is no excuse not to call.
