



You're in the middle of dinner or watching the climatic end of your favorite television show. Maybe you have guests over to the house for the evening or are in the middle of helping your children with homework. In any case, the last thing you want to do is



answer an untimely phone call from a telemarketer. Nelson Telephone Cooperative has the perfect solution - Telemarketer Call Screening.

For just pennies per day, the Telemarketer Call



Screening service from Nelson Telephone intercepts telemarketing calls before your phone even rings. The service recognizes and allows calls from friends and relatives while screening out those unpleasant telemarketing phone surprises.

Telemarketer Call Screening attempts to eliminate telemarketer calls to a subscriber by screening suspected telemarketer calls before ringing the subscriber. The service intercepts calls that are delivered as "unknown" or "out of area" to the subscribers line. The service plays an announcement stating



that the party they have dialed does not accept calls from telemarketers, and that the party would like his/her name to be added to the Telemarketers "Do No Call" list. Other callers are asked to dial "1" or stay on the line to ring through. You do not have to activate anything for telemarketer call screening to work.

# **Is Your Child Safe Online?**

While the Internet offers a world of educational and entertainment options for young people, it also has a dark and dangerous side we must be aware of.

## Below are ten tips for safe Internet usage:

- (1) Use online filters such as www.bsafehome.com, www.netnanny.com or www.cybersitter.com to ensure your child doesn't visit inappropriate sites;
- (2) Do not allow your child to instant message on such sites as Yahoo Messenger and Eyeball Chat;
- (3) Do not allow your children to engage in online gaming;
- (4) Do not allow your children to have a personal site on MySpace.com or similar networking sites, particularly where they place personal information that could be of interest to criminals;
- (5) Place home computers in a common area and not in a child's bedroom:
- (6) Use monitoring software available at www.guardiansoftware.com or www.spectorsoft.com;
- (7) Never forget the need for parental supervision and trust your child, but also verify where the child is going to on the Internet;
- (8) Know that children can attempt to circumvent software filters:
- (9) Know where, outside of the home, where your child could get online; and
- (10) Make sure your child is careful with cell and video phones.

rom time to time Nelson Telephone Cooperative will receive notice that a copyright was violated through use of a file sharing program under its internet connection. File sharing or P2P (point-to-point) programs are a popular way to share files with others that have the same P2P programs. However, much of this sharing violates the copyrights on the files-usually songs, games, movies, and software programs.

You can violate a copyright even if the file is legally yours or is not even on your hard drive. If you have a file sharing program, then any files on your computer can be shared with others or your computer can be used to courier files for others who cannot share directly. Also, if you have an

unsecured wireless router, you could be supplying the internet to somebody who is violating the copyright, but it

falls under your connection.

If Nelson Telephone receives notice that a copyright was violated by one of its customers a \$50.00 service charge will be assessed to the account on which the violation occurred. This service charge is to help cover the costs that Nelson Telephone incurs. It is very important to secure your wireless router so that someone isn't accessing your internet without your knowledge. If you need assistance with encrypting your wireless connection, Nelson Telephone technicians can assist you over the phone at no charge, or \$60.00 for a home visit.
